The different comfort zones (CF I - IV) result from the user's body size. The accommodation of frequently or regularly used clothing should be planned in CF I and CF II. With increasing age, the comfort zones shift considerably. It is therefore all the more important that the planned interior system also adapts to your living situation. Accessories such as pull-outs, shelves, wire baskets or clothes lifts play a major role especially in CF II to CF IV and can be easily retrofitted with raumplus interior systems.
