THE NECESSARY DISTANCE

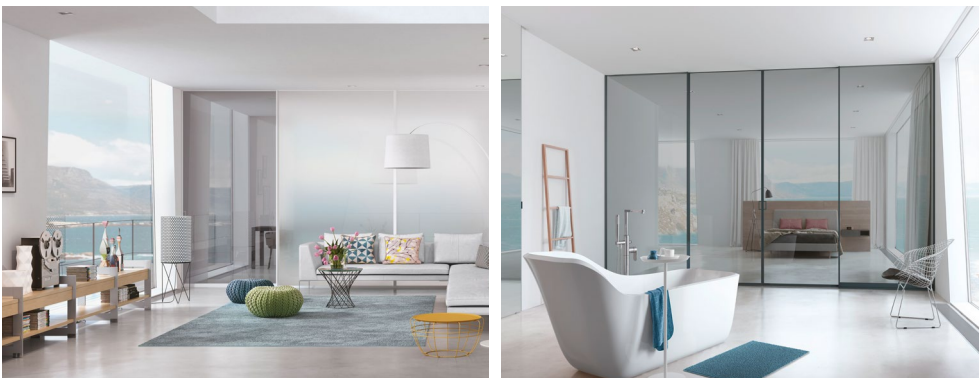

And in public spaces, arguments such as discretion or prevention of infection create a need for action in terms of separate rooms. With sliding door and partition wall systems from raumplus, these can be flexibly furnished anywhere. And elegantly provide the necessary distance.



»Keep your distance, please«, this motto has long been valid in many areas of public life: in banks, notary's offices or law firms, agencies or medical practices, confidential discussions require spatial discretion, in the health care sector it is also important to prevent infection. This is an aspect that has become highly topical worldwide. But even in the private sphere, the temporary separation of home office, kitchen, media and rest area, for example, ensures a cleverly structured coexistence.



This is made possible by **raumplus** with its versatile mobile partitioning systems. The Bremen-based family business is the international epitome of sliding doors, partition walls and interior systems in a variety of technical and visual variants – custom-made and Made in Germany. They divide open-plan offices into personal workplaces, doctors' and physiotherapists' practices into tailor-made treatment and therapy rooms, or equip banks and law firms with visually and acoustically separated consultation rooms.



In some fields of application in the commercial sector, but especially in private households, it is sufficient to make this division only temporarily. In this case, sliding doors can be used to create temporary rooms in no time at all, which can then be reopened for the big picture. The mobile room dividers hold cooking fumes, for example, smells and noises from the adjoining living room, separate the bedroom from the bathroom or the home office from the leisure area.



The design options for room separation are just as varied as their possible applications: Door panels in frosted or clear glass, various wood decors or lacquered surfaces in all shades of the RAL scale are framed by silver-coloured, bronzed or powder-coated aluminium frames and can be additionally equipped with dividing rails, handles etc. in a range of mix & match materials. If you want to put your company CI or a particularly successful photo motif in the spotlight, this can be realised by digital printing on the door panels.

Permanently installed, or guided in floor or ceiling rails, **raumplus** offers room separation for all architectural specifications from loft to old building and full apartment to sloped roof. Made to measure with the know-how and precision craftsmanship of our Bremen team.
